Sunday Seconds: "One God, One Faith" (for small group discussion or personal reflection)

Ephesians 4:1-6 – May 26, 2024

- 1. Sometimes people say they can be a Christian without having a church. What does this scripture say about that?
- Verse 2 talks about being humble. Sometimes in life we are humbled and sometimes we choose to humble ourselves. Read Isaiah 66:1-2. To whom does God choose to give favor?
- 3. Colossians 3 is quite similar about forgiveness, which is sometimes hard. How does the advice in v13 help us?
- 4. The Early Church called Jesus "the Lord." Read 1 Corinthians 8:5-6. We who look to Jesus as lord—both God and our personal master—must look to His other subjects as what? How does it affect how we talk to them? ...or how we disagree with them?
- 5. Were you surprised to see "baptism" in such a short list of important aspects of Jesus' church? Why do you think this is?
- 6. If there is no unity among believers, there is no body of Christ. How do we contribute to the unity of the body?
