- 4. Pastor Eric said that righteousness is the sense that things are right in us, the result of holy living and goodness. Ephesians 5:1-2 says something about this as does 8-10. Have you experienced this? If so, please share.
- 5. To find strength as a Christian, God guides us to other believers to help us along the way. See Proverbs 27:17. Do you have brothers or sisters in Christ who do this for you?
